

# Karyopharm to Present Clinical Data Update for Selinexor (KPT-330) in Hematologic Malignancies

(Nasdaq:KPTI), a clinical-stage pharmaceutical company, today announced the presentation of clinical data for its lead drug candidate, selinexor (KPT-330), a first-in-class, oral Selective Inhibitor of Nuclear Export / SINE™ compound, during a Karyopharm-sponsored event with webcast scheduled for Monday, December 7, 2015 from 8:30 - 9:30 p.m. ET, immediately following formal programming for the 57th American Society of Hematology (ASH) Annual Meeting.
